Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Hastings, Nebraska was conducted in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 220 N. Hastings Avenue, on June 13, 2016.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. in Regular Session by Mayor Powers with the following members present: Michael Krings, Ginny Skutnik, Chuck Niemeyer, Sarah Hoops, Phil Odom, John Harrington, Kathy Duval, Everett Goebel. Absent: None.

The Mayor led the group in recital of the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America.

Moved by Chuck Niemeyer seconded by Ginny Skutnik to amend the June 13, 2016 Regular Meeting agenda to remove Item No. 4(b.) Ordinance No. 4477. 2.(a)Public Hearing on the request of Tim Quigley of Cohen-Esrey Affordable Partners, Developer, and Paul Simmering and Randal Chick, Director of the Community Redevelopment Authority, property owners, to rezone property from District I-1, Light Industrial to District C-3, Commercial Business District at 219 W. 2nd Street and 227 W. 2nd Street.

Tim Quigley, Cohen-Esrey Affordable Partners, spoke in support. No further public testimony was heard. No objections were received by the City Clerk. The Mayor declared the hearing closed.

Ordinance No. 4479. . . Amending the official Zoning District Map of the City of Hastings to rezone property from I-1, Light Industrial District to C-3, Commercial Business District.

2.(c) Public Hearing on levying assessments in Street Improvement Districts Nos. 2013-1, 2013-2 and 2013-3.

The Mayor declared that in accordance with published notice, it was now time to conduct a hearing relative to the levy of special assessments in Street Improvement District Nos. 2013-1, 2013-2 and 2013-3 and declared the public hearing open. The Mayor then asked if there were any persons present who wished to be heard concerning the proposed assessments in said District Nos. 2013-1, 2013-2 and 2013-3.

No public testimony was heard on the following projects: Street Improvement District No. 2013-1(Merle Avenue from the south right-of-way line of North Shore Drive north to the north right-of-way line of Lakeridge Drive, including the intersections at North Shore Drive and Lakeridge Drive); Street Improvement District No. 2013-2(Nalan Drive from a point 100.00 feet north of West 13th Street north to the north right-of-way line of the intersection with West 14th Street/Meander Circle, then east a distance of 200.00 feet from said intersection and west a distance of 150.00 feet from said intersection, said improvements shall include the intersection of Nalan Drive and West 14th Street/Meander Circle); Street Improvement District No. 2013-3(Wendell Drive from the existing paving North a distance of 150.00 feet to West 33rd Street, and West 33rd Street from the existing paving West a distance of 115.00 feet to Wendell Drive including the intersection of Wendell Drive and West 33rd Street)

3.(a) Moved by Chuck Niemeyer seconded by Michael Krings to approve the Redevelopment Agreement with City Block Center Hospitality, L.L.C., a Nebraska limited liability company, City Block Center Housing, L.L.C., a Nebraska limited liability company, and City Block Center Mixed-Use, L.L.C., a Nebraska limited liability company, for the City Block Project in downtown Hastings.

Discussion was held regarding estimates of cost and commitment for the City's portion of the project.

Mayor Powers stated that the City subsidizes other amenities. Jeff Hassenstab, Director of Parks & Recreation, stated the City subsidizes the Auditorium by approximately \$80,000 annually at this time.

Mr. Ptak, City Attorney, stated that Section 4 of the Redevelopment Agreement has been put in place for parking issues.

Roger Bullington (Chief Construction) is waiting on a signed Redevelopment Agreement and already has an operation agreement crafted. No issues have been foreseen in coming to an agreement with Hastings College. There is no finalized hotel commitment at this time. The preconstruction team reviewed and is comfortable with project scope & cost discussed.

Overview

The City of Hastings participated in this hazard mitigation plan in order to reduce the risk to human life and property from hazards. Their participation was extensive; a representative from Hastings attended every public meeting, met individually with members from the planning team, completed all hazard identification and project identification worksheets, engaged the general public in the planning process, and assisted in interdepartmental coordination and data analysis.

For Hastings, the issues of top concern that were identified through this planning process include hail, high winds, severe thunderstorms, severe winter storms, and tornados. The projects of highest priority identified to address these issues include purchasing new outdoor warning sirens and obtaining a backup generator.

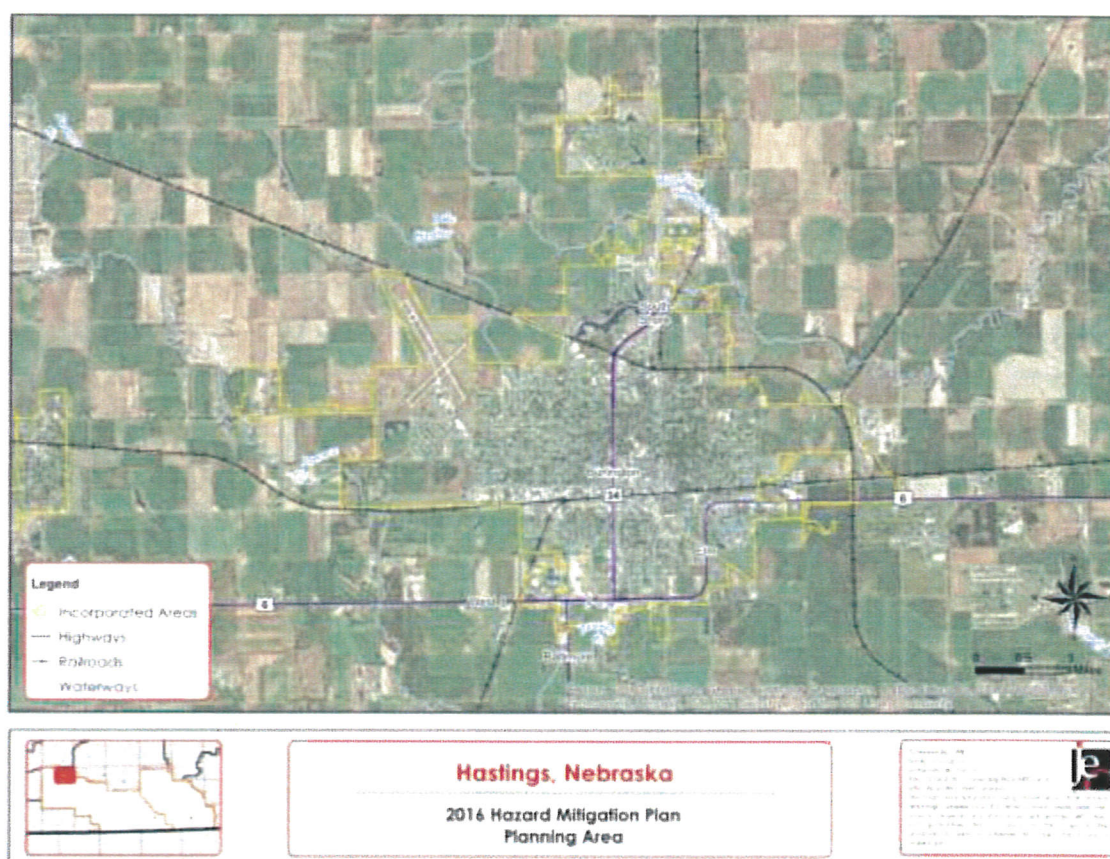

Location/Geography/Climate

The City of Hastings is located in the north eastern portion of Adams County.

The City of Hastings covers an approximate area of 13.6 square miles. Major waterways within the area include the West Fork Big Blue River, which enters the community in the northeast before depositing water in Lake Hastings, which is in the northern part of the city. There are also two smaller lakes in the city; one is located in Heartwell Park, with a stream running through the campus of Hastings College, and another lake on the western edge of the city. The area is not heavily forested, nor is located in a geographic area of the state prone to landslides. Most of Hastings lies in the plains topographic region, and is surrounded by agricultural fields.

In Hastings, the average high temperature for the month of July is 89.6 degrees and the average low temperature for the month of January is 13.6 degrees. On average, Hastings gets 26.15 inches of rain and 26.4 inches of snowfall per year. The following table compares these climate indicators with those of the entire state.

Transportation

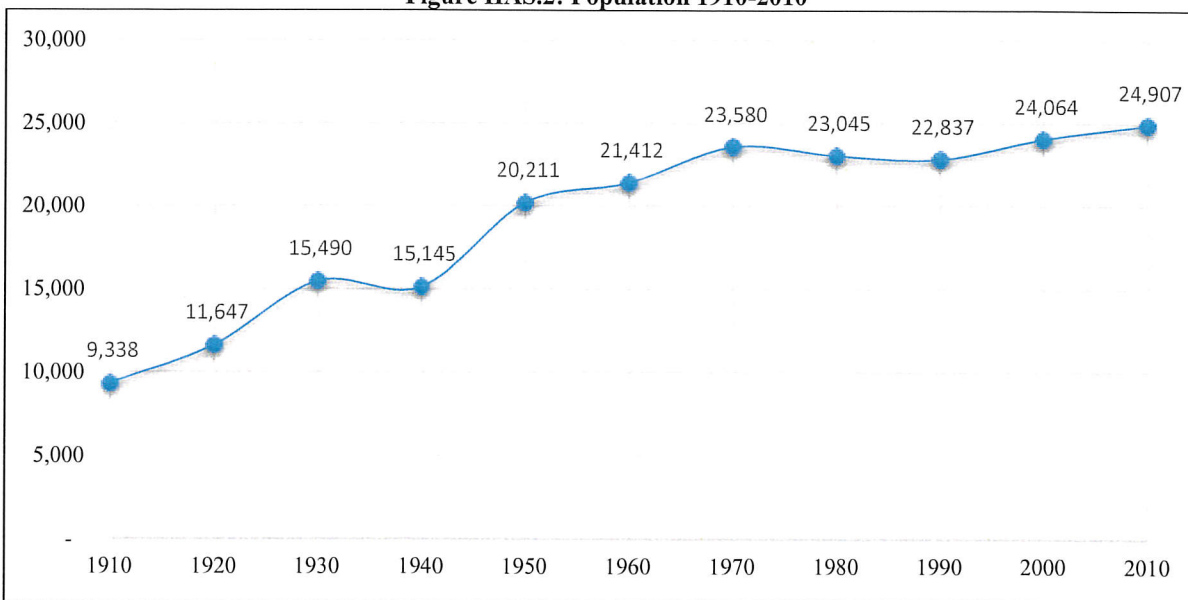
Hastings's major transportation corridors include State Highway 281, which runs north-south through the center of Hastings. NE-281 accommodates on average 10,155 vehicles per day, 1,010 of which are heavy commercial vehicles. State Highway 6 runs east-west through the southern portion of Hastings. NE-6 accommodates on average 3,250 vehicles per day, 415 of which are heavy commercial vehicles. It should be noted that these traffic figures reflect data from 2012. The City of Hastings indicated these numbers were likely higher as of 2015.

Hastings has three rail lines, Union Pacific and Burlington Northern line. At Hastings, the Union Pacific line travels from southeast to northwest. Hastings acts as a hub for the Burlington Northern line, rail lines lead east-west and northeast-south. This information is important to hazard mitigation plans insofar as it suggests possible evacuation corridors in the community, as well as areas more at risk to transportation incidents.

Demographics

The following figure displays the historical population trend from 1910 to 2010. This figure indicates that the population of Hastings grown since 1910, with steady growth over the past two decades. This is relevant to hazard mitigation because communities with a growing population may be more prone to developing additional land and building new structures. Net population growth may increase the number of people and properties vulnerable to hazards.

This is relevant to hazard mitigation insofar as the very young and elderly populations may be more vulnerable to certain hazards than others. 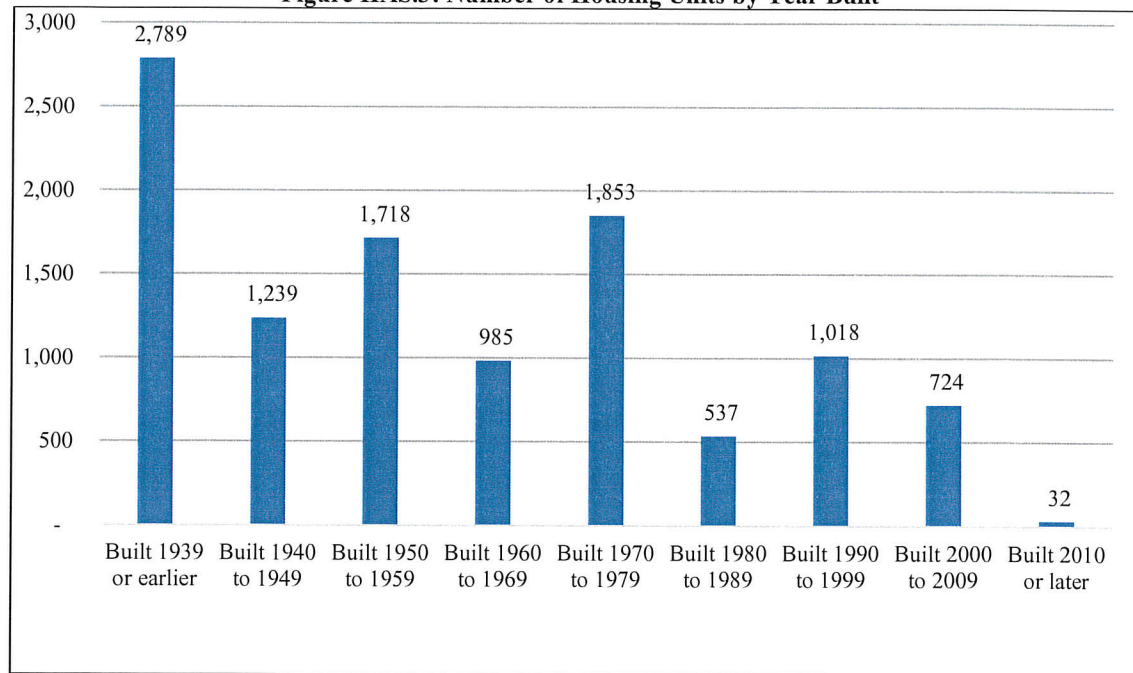

The following figure indicates that the majority of the housing in Hastings was built prior to 1980. According to 2009-2013 ACS 5-year estimates, the community has 10,847 housing units; with 93.2 percent of those units occupied. There are approximately 501 mobile homes in the community and 52.8 percent of the community's housing was built before 1960. This housing information is relevant to hazard mitigation insofar as the age of housing may indicate which housing units were built prior to state building codes being developed. Further, unoccupied housing may suggest that future development may be less likely to occur. Finally, communities with a substantial number of mobile homes may be more vulnerable to the impacts of high winds, tornados, and severe winter storms.

The City noted that although the Census estimates that 32 new housing units have been built, it is likely closer to 100 new housing units since 2010

Future Development Trends

Hastings has experienced development over the past five years, however, the exact number of structures is unknown. All development is guided by the City's comprehensive plan, which contains detailed land use maps promoting smart and safe growth. In the past five years, new development did not occur in particularly hazardous areas. Over the next five years, the city will use its comprehensive plan to ensure development occurs in a safe and smart manner. Information about the City's comprehensive plan can be found in the plan integration section of this participation section.

In the next five years, the majority of growth in Hastings is expected to occur along the HWY-281 corridor. Growth undertaken along this transportation corridor will be guided by the comprehensive plan, and done so in way to limit vulnerability to future transportation incidents. Permit reports from 2011 through 2014 indicated that 157 new residential buildings were constructed, along with 17 commercial structures. This development is not reported to have occurred in known hazardous areas.

Structural Inventory and Valuation

A structural inventory was completed for the corporate limits by using the Adams County Assessor GIS data. Results from the structural inventory completed are found in the table below. This information is relevant for hazard mitigation plans insofar as it presents a larger picture of the structural makeup of the community.

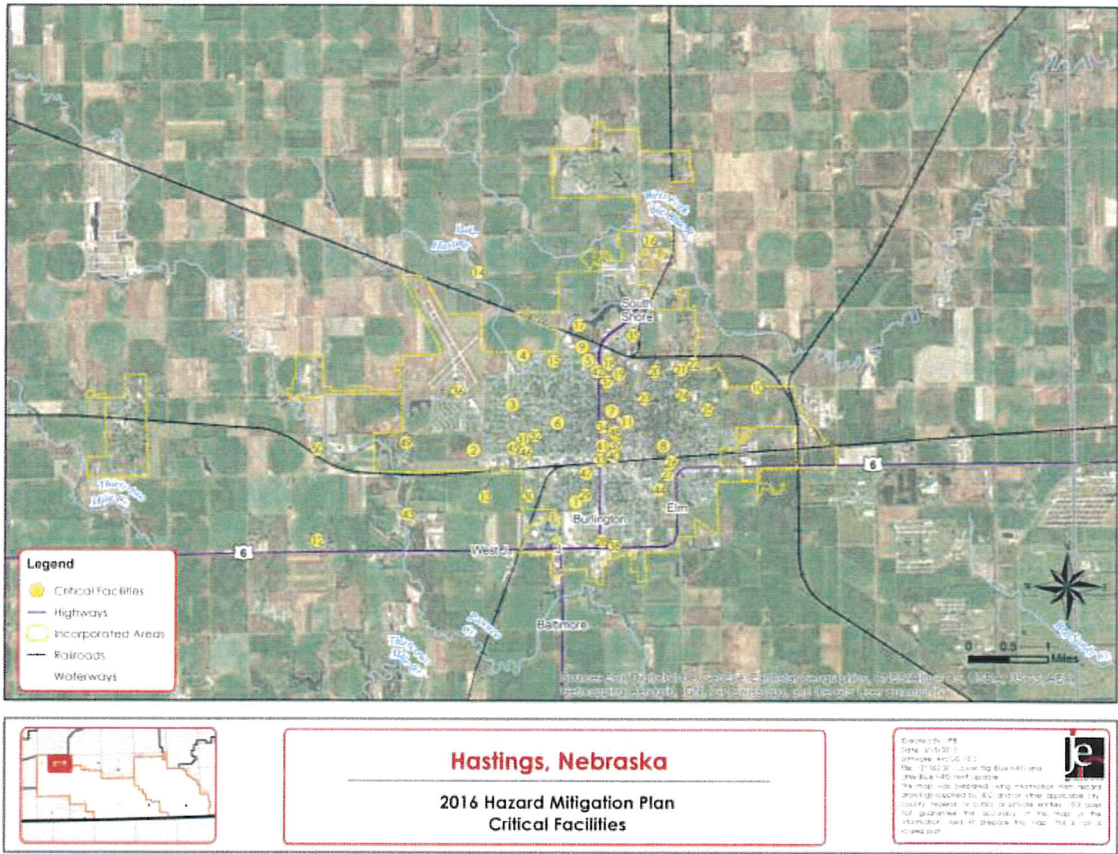

Hail

Hastings frequently experiences damaging hailstorms – some of them significantly damaging. Most notably in recent years, storms on June 14, 2014 produced golf ball to softball size hail in Hastings, causing \$125,000 in property damage and extensive crop damage. Other hailstorms on May 11, 2014 produced an additional \$375,000 in property damage. Yet another series of storms in Hastings on May 2, 2012 generated near \$2.5 million in property damage, with hailstones ranging from quarter to softball size. Property damage is the city's main worry from hailstorms.

The City of Hastings does not have a local tree board, or provide residents with information regarding hail-resistant building materials with their building permits. The city's critical facilities are not fitted with hail-resistant materials, and have experienced hail damage in the past. The facilities are insured against hail damage.

High Winds

Hastings is prone to high wind events, though critical facilities have not been damaged by these events in recent years. The city backs-up its municipal records. The city does not have a community safe room, so residents must rely on their own or a neighbor's basement or storm shelter for safety. Adams County emergency management does offer text alerts to warn of severe weather, and engages in outreach to educate the public about hazards at community events.

For this plan update, Hastings has included projects to purchase a backup generator, bury power lines, and develop a tree maintenance program, all things that could mitigate this hazard.

Severe Thunderstorms

Hastings frequently experiences damaging severe thunderstorms. Most notably in recent years, a storm generating 83 mph thunderstorm winds caused \$150,000 in property damage at the Hastings Airport and elsewhere in the city on August 17, 2014. Storms with thunderstorm winds of 79 mph caused another \$105,000 in damage in town on June 14, 2014. Yet another storm on August 22, 2007 caused \$250,000 in property damage from its 66 mph winds. Recent data from the National Climatic Data Center show frequent, damaging storms in Hastings with winds exceeding 60 mph, and even 70 mph. City officials are concerned about property damage and injuries to people from severe thunderstorms.

Critical electronic municipal records are protected with surge protectors. Critical facilities, such as City Hall, the public library, and the museum, do not have portable generators. About 20 percent of the power lines in the village are buried. There hazardous trees that need to be removed. Critical facilities in town have weather radios.

For this plan update, Hastings has included projects to purchase a backup generator, bury power lines, and develop a tree maintenance program, all things that could mitigate this hazard.

Severe Winter Storms

Adams County frequently experiences severe winter weather, with heavy snowfall, high winds, and sometimes crippling ice accumulations. Several of these systems have impacted Hastings in recent years, per the National Climatic Data Center. Extremely cold temperatures can accompany these systems, such as

when a winter storm on February 1, 2011 was followed by wind chills approaching 35 degrees below zero in Hastings. The city's main concerns from severe winter storms are snow removal, property damage, and public safety.

The city owns dump trucks and loaders, and the Hastings Street Department is in charge of snow removal. The village believes these resources are sufficient for snow removal. The city uses a few snow fences, and has some designated snow routes. About 20 percent of the power lines in the village are buried. For this plan update, Hastings has included projects to purchase a backup generator, bury power lines, and develop a tree maintenance program, all things that could mitigate this hazard.

Tornados

Hastings is prone to damaging tornados. An EF-0 tornado on August 22, 2007, with winds of 75 mph caused \$25,000 in damage in town. This was part of the same storm system, on the same day that also caused \$250,000 in damage in Hastings from straight-line thunderstorm winds, and \$145,000 in additional damage from flash flooding. An F-1 tornado on June 7, 1994 just north of Hastings caused several million dollars worth of crop damage. The city's main concerns from tornados are loss of life and crop damage. Critical facilities in Hastings have been damaged by tornados.

The city backs-up its municipal records. The city does not have a community safe room, so residents must rely on their own or a neighbor's basement or storm shelter for safety. Adams County emergency management does offer text alerts to warn of severe weather, and engages in outreach to educate the public about hazards at community events. The city has mutual aid agreements in place with the 15 counties that are part of the South Central Planning, Exercise, and Training Region in Nebraska, including Adams, Buffalo, Clay, Dawson, Franklin, Frontier, Gosper, Hall, Hamilton, Harlan, Kearney, Lincoln, Nuckolls, Phelps, and Webster Counties.

For this plan update, Hastings has included projects to update outdoor warning sirens, purchase a backup generator, bury power lines, and develop a tree maintenance program, all things that could mitigate this hazard.

Dam Failure

Hastings is protected by the Hastings Dam, located 1.9 miles northwest of Hastings. The County LEOP outlines roles and responsibilities related to dam failure response. If the dam were to fail, a large portion of the city would be inundated. In terms of mitigation, the city has included a project to repair or replace this dam as part of this plan update.

Transportation Incidents

Hastings has expressed concerns about monitoring traffic conditions to improve traffic safety. Traffic accidents are a routine occurrence in Hastings. As part of this plan update, Hastings included a project for camera system improvements.

Governance

A community's governance indicates the number of boards or offices that may be available to help implement hazard mitigation actions. Hastings has a number of offices or departments that may be involved in implementing hazard mitigation initiatives. The city has a mayor, an eight member city council, a city administrator, clerk, treasurer, and a variety of other departments.

Capability Assessment

The capability assessment consisted of two main components: a Capability Assessment Survey completed by the jurisdiction and a review of local existing policies, regulations, plans, and the programs. The survey

is used to gather information regarding the jurisdiction's planning and regulatory capability; administrative and technical capability; fiscal capability; and educational and outreach capability.

Plan Integration

Building safe and smart communities can be accomplished through effective plan integration. Integrating hazard mitigation principles into other local planning mechanisms, such as plans addressing land use, transportation, climate change, sustainability, natural and cultural resource protection, watershed management, economic development and others can greatly increase an area's level of resiliency. While this HMP planning process involved interdepartmental coordination at the local level, this planning process also sought to analyze how existing planning mechanisms were presently integrated and make suggestions for further integration.

The plans listed in the preceding table were analyzed using guidance from FEMA's 2014 *Plan Integration Guide*. The following paragraph presents a summary of the findings of this analysis.

The City of Hastings has a Comprehensive Plan, a Capital Improvements Plan, a Hazard Mitigation Plan, and Economic Development Plan, a Local Emergency Operations Plan (LEOP), a Floodplain Management Plan, a Stormwater Management Plan, zoning and subdivision regulations, a Floodplain Ordinance, and Building Codes. The city's LEOP was updated in 2013, and is an annex of the LEOP for Adams County. The LEOP is an all-hazards plan that provides clear assignments of responsibility in case of an emergency.

The City's Comprehensive Plan was written in 2010. The plan outlines long term goals for Hastings, including future growth recommendations. The plan includes a goal to "prevent flooding caused by overflow of our water bodies" and to promote general safety of all residents. The comprehensive plan also contains a series of action items, including many that could be coordinated with actions listed in the mitigation plan. The comprehensive plan does have actions to prohibit development in the floodplain and to promote smart growth throughout the city and host of their water initiatives related to sustainability. Examples of some of these include promote pervious areas, implementing low impact street design, promoting the use of rain gardens, promoting renewable energy, creating a stormwater master plan, and more.

Figure HAS.5: Hastings Future Land Use Map

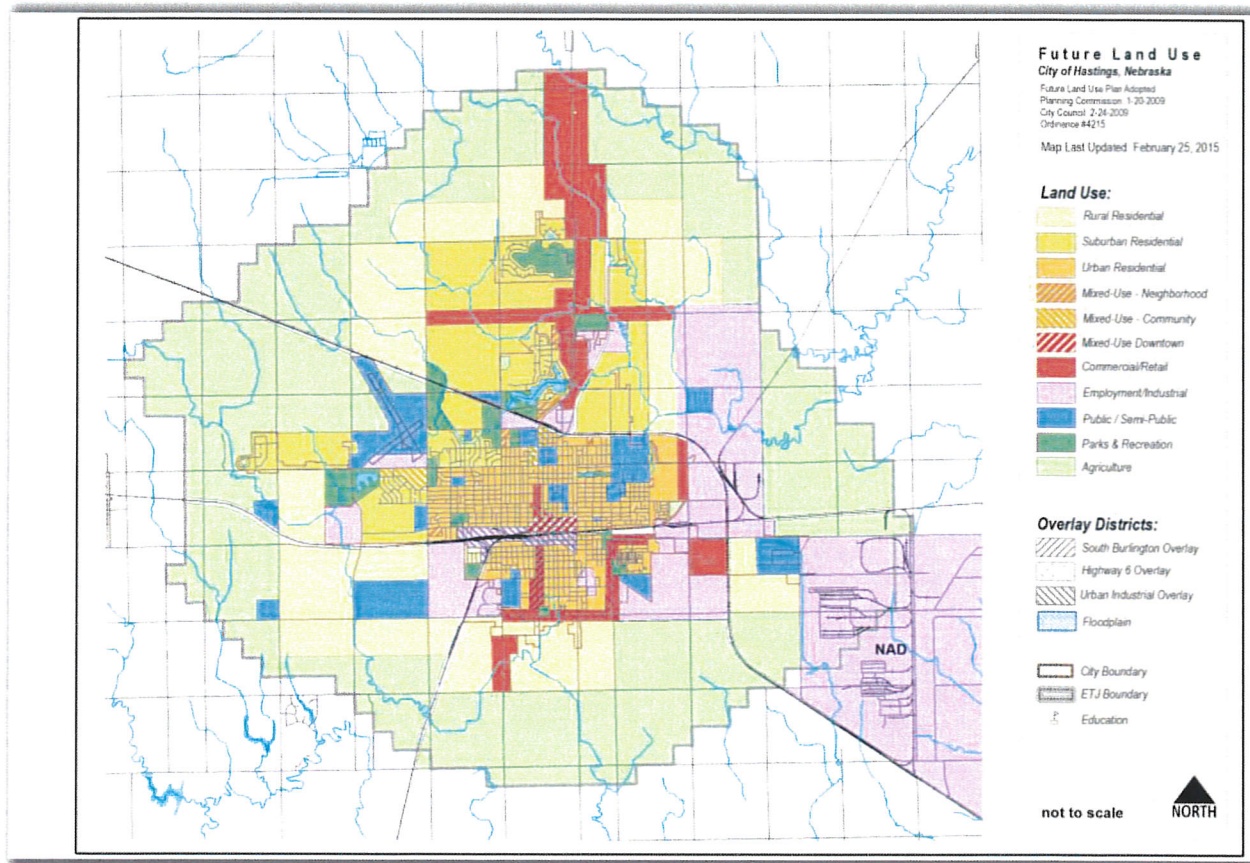
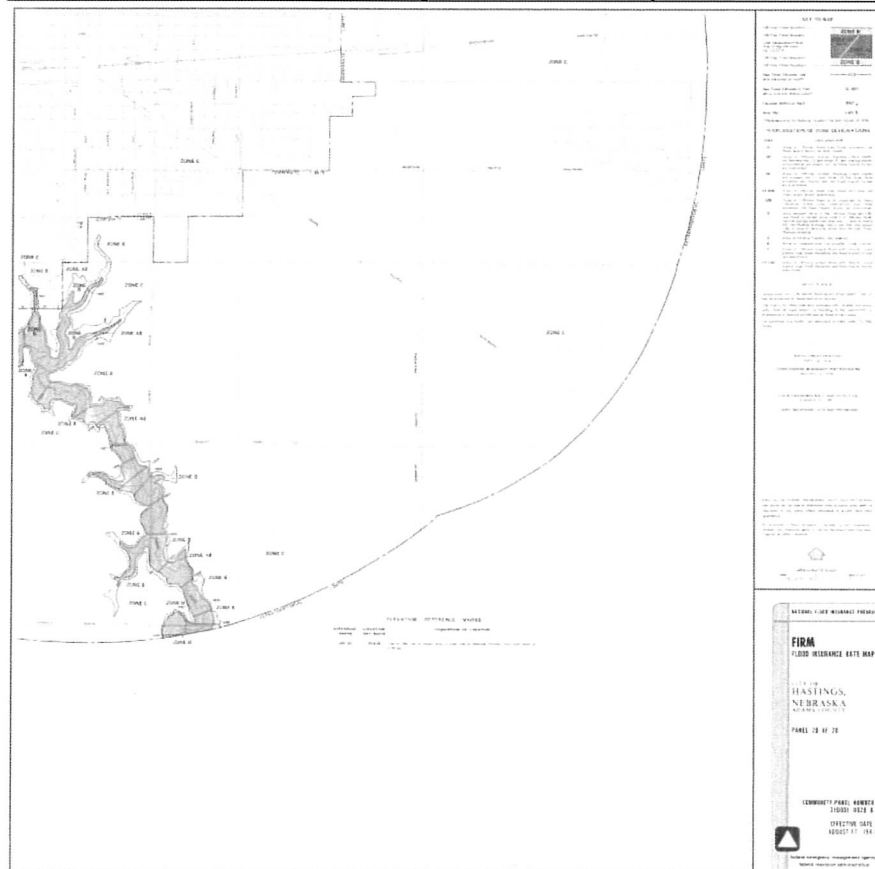


Figure HAS.6: Hasting Flood Insurance Rate Map
